The study highlighted to use of whatsapp among LIS student. The study resulted into the comparative analysis of various features of using WhatsApp as a communication tool in students. The students massively believe that the app enriches their academic experience; increases social contacts and relations; has positive impacts on their academic performancesas well as fosters communication with their lecturers.

Kaur, Simerjit undertook a study entitled "Use of WhatsApp Instant Messenger among Undergraduate Degree Students of D.A.V. College Pundri (Kaithal) Haryana: A Study"². The study resulted into the Comparative analysis of various features of using WhatsApp as a communication tool in students where they share images, messages and videos in festival times more and it is less used for sharing job vacancies.

Yaboah and Ewur studied the impact of whatsApp messenger usage on students performance in tertiary institutions in Ghana.³ The study resulted that whatsApp instead of making communication easier and faster thereby enhancing effective flow of information and idea sharing among students, rather

have impacted negatively on the performance of students.

Tandale, Manisha studied the use of whatsaap as a tool for information Dissemination in the college of western region in Mumbai. The study resulted that WhatsApp is used by all respondents for sharing academic information compared to other messaging applications such as Google, Yahoo, Facebook, Twitter, Google Hangout, Instagram, Skype, We Chat, Kik, Viber, Voxer Walkie-Talkie and Snapchat. Mostly timetable, notices and notes are shared at large scale by students.

Daily Notes are shared on WhatsApp by 223 (82.59%) students, notices by 237 (87.77%), Question papers by 150 (55.55%), Assignment by 201 (74.44%), time table by 80 (29.62%) students, , chapter clippings 238 (88.14%), subject content by 261 (96.66%), news updates by 193 (71.48%%), for queries by 148 (54.81%) for syllabus 136 (50.37%), topic discussion 258 (95.55%) activities photos sharing 249 (92.22%), and for examination related news & guidance by 268 (99.25%)%), students used WhatsApp as information dissemination tool.

Summary & Findings:

Male students(136) were more than female students (134). The ratio of participation of students is different from faculty wise. The large number of

students access and use WhatsApp from last three years. All students have the data connectivity to their smartphones. WhatsApp is used by all respondents for sharing academic information. Mostly examination related news & guidance, subject content and topic discussion are shared at large scale by students.
