

A Study on Students Satisfaction of Online Learning During Covid-19, With Reference to Commerce Students of Latur City

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Abstract:-

This research paper focuses, on the students' satisfaction with online learning. Due to Covid-19, India is facing several problems. Positive Covid-19 pandemic created a lot of challenges in the Indian education system. Students started learning through online mode from the March-2020 (i.e. 24 March-2020) the phase 1 started and still in 2021 is suffering also hence, E-learning is also challenging for students as schools and colleges are not opened because another set of lockdown seems imminent, with no tallies when the situation will be back under control. Hence, this research paper's objective is to find out students' satisfaction with E-learning.

Introduction:-

E-learning is a learning system based on formalized teaching but with the help of electronic research i.e. mobile phone, Laptop, Computer etc. Computer + Internet is major form of E-learning. For E-learning students make use of self-paced learning, and to choose their own learning environments. There are various factors which are considered in online learning. Hypothesis:-

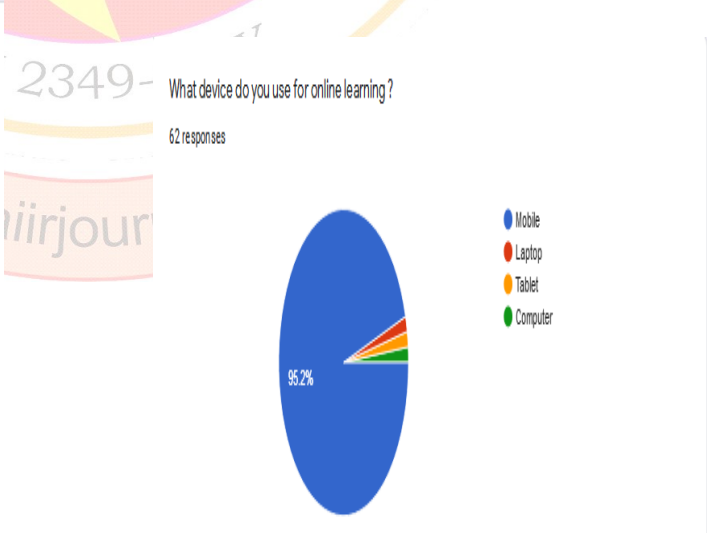
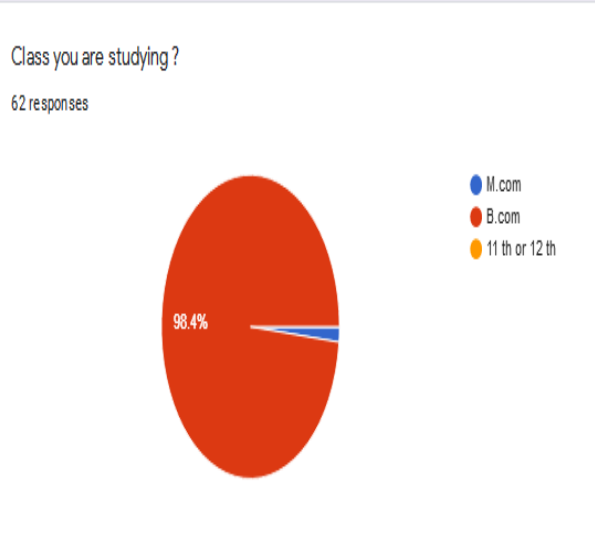
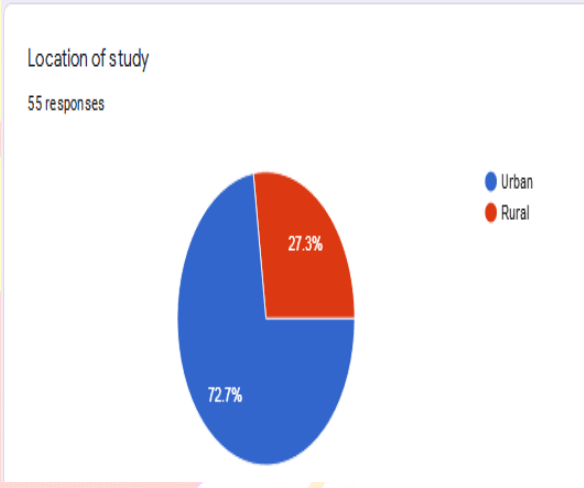
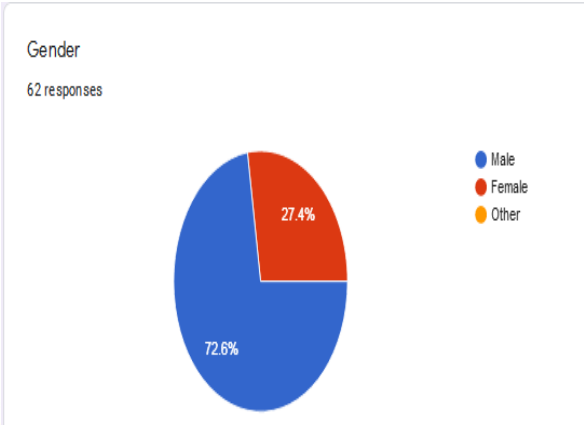
1. Students are satisfied in E-learning
2. Students are more satisfied in offline lectures.

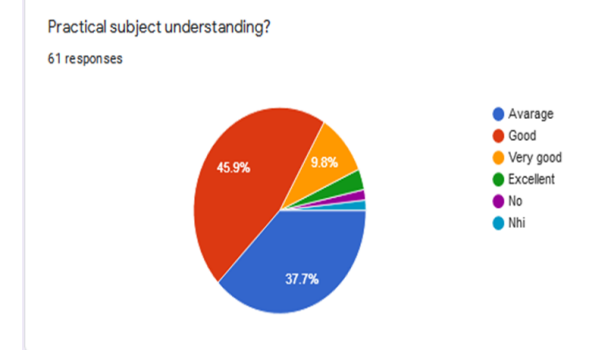
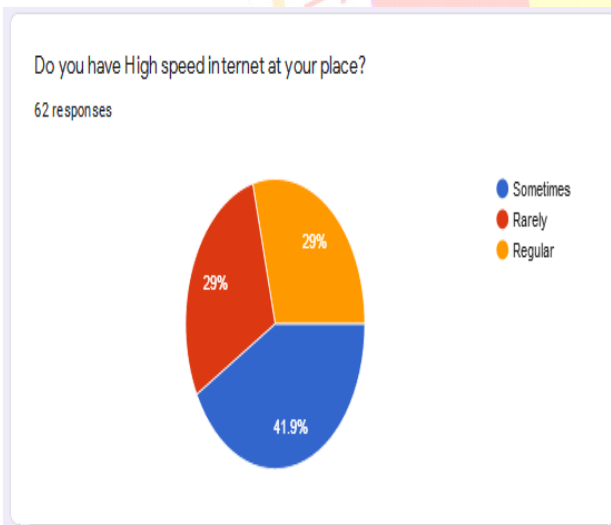
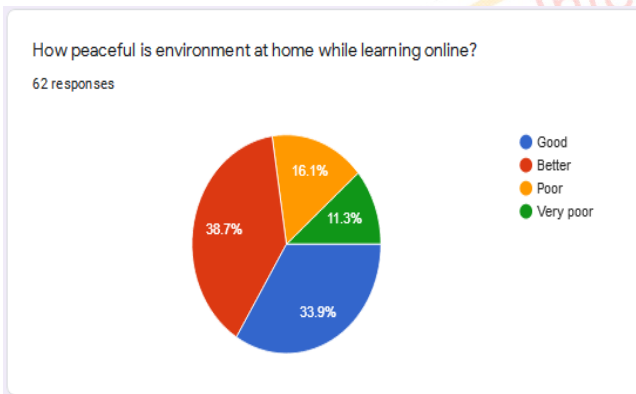
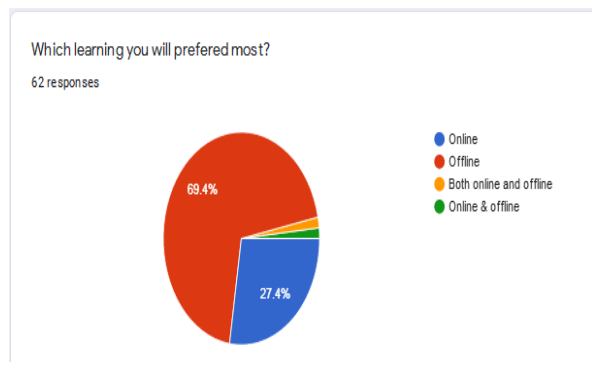
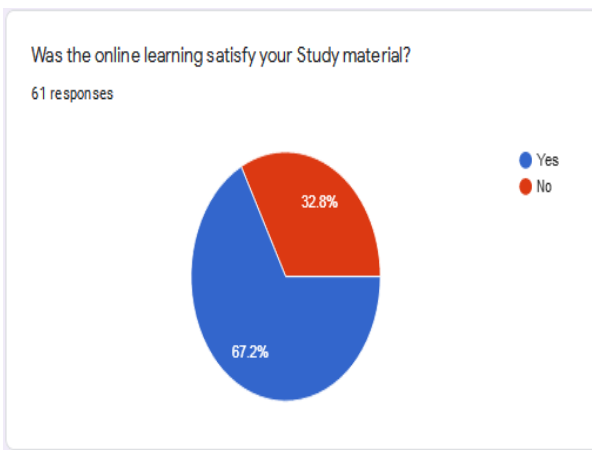
Research Methodology :-

The study participants were from, B.COM, M.COM students. Enrolled in commerce field of Latur, city.60 students completed the survey by online mode this survey is of academic year 2020-2021.

For the online survey, I adopted on series of questionnaires for meaning the student’s satisfaction with their online learning experience. Students were provided link of complete questionnaires using Google form, hence, their satisfaction and preparation of online features were measured at the end of semester.

Findings:-

A series of correlation calculated to examine the relationships of characteristics of active and their comfort for online learning.

The data analysis to address the present research question indicated that

1. Students mostly having a problem with technology barriers i.e. high net speed i.e.
2. Students are also having a problem with practical subject. i.e. accounts and finance i.e. not conceptual understanding with practical subject with total online learning.
3. The major finding is the students are preferring for offline classes as they are not conceptually clear with practical subject and also technical problem.
4. Students who live in rural or remote area there is electricity problem i.e. power cut problems hence, these students facing the problems of electricity also.

Suggestions:-

By keeping seriousness in mind about covid-19 pandemic suggestions are these ways-

1. Students are not 100% satisfied with online learning hence it can be say that offline classes can be arranged by shift wise i.e. fixing a day for class and no. of students hence it will avoid the rush and prevent from corona virus also.
2. It is found that some students are not satisfied with audio lectures hence, it should make compulsory to teachers for starting video lectures for students more understanding.
3. Education system reforms by taking consideration of modern technology i.e. study apps for study material, websites.
 - 1] As this covid -19 lockdown is changing education pattern. It is estimated that now next few years' education will be online. Hence it is better to adopt new programmes for student's better understanding.
 - 2] Focus should be on intellectual learning's not exam only.

Conclusion:-

This paper provides a satisfied and summary foundation for the grouping of the satisfaction questions in the students outcomes survey into 2 categories 1st is basic to their personal and 2nd is with present situation they are suffering or experiencing.

Aim of this paper is to understand the student's satisfaction hence it is found that students are demanding offline learning and some advancement is teaching process.

And hence the hypothesis (H) is accepted here that students are more satisfied with offline lectures and Ho is rejected i.e. students are satisfied is offline learning.
